Legacy Center has always made the safety of our players, their families, coaches, umpires, spectators, and staff paramount. Legacy continues to modify and adjust recommendations and policies for visitors of the Legacy Center to align with new governmental orders and CDC guidelines as they become available.

The latest Executive Order 2020-147 (July 10, 2020) applies to *everyone* visiting Legacy.

The following conditions of the order are pertinent to the Legacy Center.

Everyone must wear a face covering when

- In any indoor public space
- Outdoors and unable to consistently maintain a distance of six feet or more

Exceptions

- Young children under 5 years of age (still recommended they wear if possible)
- Cannot medically tolerate a face covering
- Are eating or drinking while seated
- Are exercising when wearing a face covering would interfere in the activity
- Are communicating with a hearing impaired or otherwise disabled individual where the ability to see the mouth is essential to communication

What does this mean for Baseball and Softball outdoors at the Legacy Center?

1. In the field of play, players do not have to wear face coverings; however, is permitted if the player chooses to wear a face covering.
2. In the dugouts, a face covering must be worn.
 - a. Some coaches and players may opt to not use the dugout
 - b. Players may wear a face covering around their necks to simply pull them up when entering the dugout and down when exiting to play.
3. Anyone not involved in the game need to take precautions to maintain a minimum distance of six feet apart
4. Anyone who are unable to maintain a distance of six feet from others should wear a face covering
